


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

Tools Required to Assemble the Machine: Two Adjustable Wrenches and Allen Wrenches NOTE: It is strongly recommended this machine be assembled by two or more people to avoid possible injury.


STEP 1 (See Diagram 1)

- A.) Connect the Front Stabilizer (#1) to the Base Frame (#3). Secure it with two M10 x 3 ¾" Carriage Bolts (#27), one Bracket (#14), two Ø ¾" Washers (#35), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#36). Repeat the same step to connect the Rear Stabilizer (#2) to the Base Frame (#3).
- B.) Attach the Lower Vertical Frame (#4) to the Base Frame (#3). Secure it with two Triangle Brackets (#13), one on each side of the Frame, five M10 x 3 ¾" Carriage Bolts (#27), Ø ¾" Washers (#35), and M10 Aircraft Nuts (#36).
- C.) Insert the Foam Roll Tube (#12) halfway through the pivot on the Frame. Slide two Foam Rolls (#25) onto the Foam Tube from both sides. Plug two Foam Caps (#24) to both ends.
- D.) Attach the Non-slip Pad (#26) onto the top of the step on the Lower Vertical Frame.




STEP 2 (See Diagram 2)

- A.) Attach Left Support Frame (#6) onto the Rear Stabilizer (#2). Secure it with a M10 x 2 ½" Allen Bolt (#30) and Ø ¾" Washer (#35) from the bottom up. Repeat the same step to install the Right Support Frame (#7) to the Rear Stabilizer.
- B.) Insert the Upper Vertical Frame (#5) into the Lower Vertical Frame (#4). Attach top of the Left & Right Support Frame (#6) & (#7) to both sides of the Frame. Align the holes and secure the Support Frames to the Vertical Frame with two M10 x 3 ¾" Carriage Bolts (#27), Ø ¾" Washers (#35), and M10 Aircraft Nuts (#36). Secure the Vertical Frame with two M10 x 3" Carriage Bolts (#28), Ø ¾" Washers (#35), M10 Aircraft Nuts (#36).
- C.) Slide two Short Grips (#18) onto the curl handles on the Support Frames.




STEP 3 (See Diagram 3)


- A.) Attach the Left Dip Support (#8) and Right Dip Support (#9) to the Upper Vertical Frame (#5). Secure them with two M10 x 3 ¾" Carriage Bolts (#27), Ø ¾" Washers (#35), and M10 Aircraft Nuts (#36).
- B.) Attach two Arm Pads (#15) to Left and Right Dip Supports. Secure each Pad with two M8 x 2 ¼" Allen Bolts (#33) and Ø 5/8" Washers (#34).
- C.) Insert two Vertical Handles (#11) into the holes on the Dip Supports. Secure them with one M10 x 5/8" Allen Bolt (#31) and \varnothing 3/4" Washer (#35) underneath each handle. Slide two \varnothing 1" Grips (#18) onto the Handles.
- E.) Slide two Sleeves (#21) onto the Handles on the Dip Supports. Then slide two \varnothing 1 3/8" Grips (#17) onto the handles.



STEP 4 (See Diagram 4)

- A.) Attach Backrest Pad (#16) to the Upper Vertical Frame (#5). Secure it with two M8 x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Allen Bolts (#32) and \bigcirc 5/8" Washers (#34).
- B.) Insert the Chin-up Bar (#10) into the top opening on the Upper Vertical Frame (#5). Secure it with one M10 x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Allen Bolt (#29), two $\frac{1}{4}$ " Washers (#35), and one M10 Aircraft Nut (#36).
- C.) Slide two Chin-up Handle Grips (#20) onto both ends of the Bar (#10).
- E.) Insert the 2 1/2" End Cap (#37) to the opening on the Chin-up Bar (#10).
